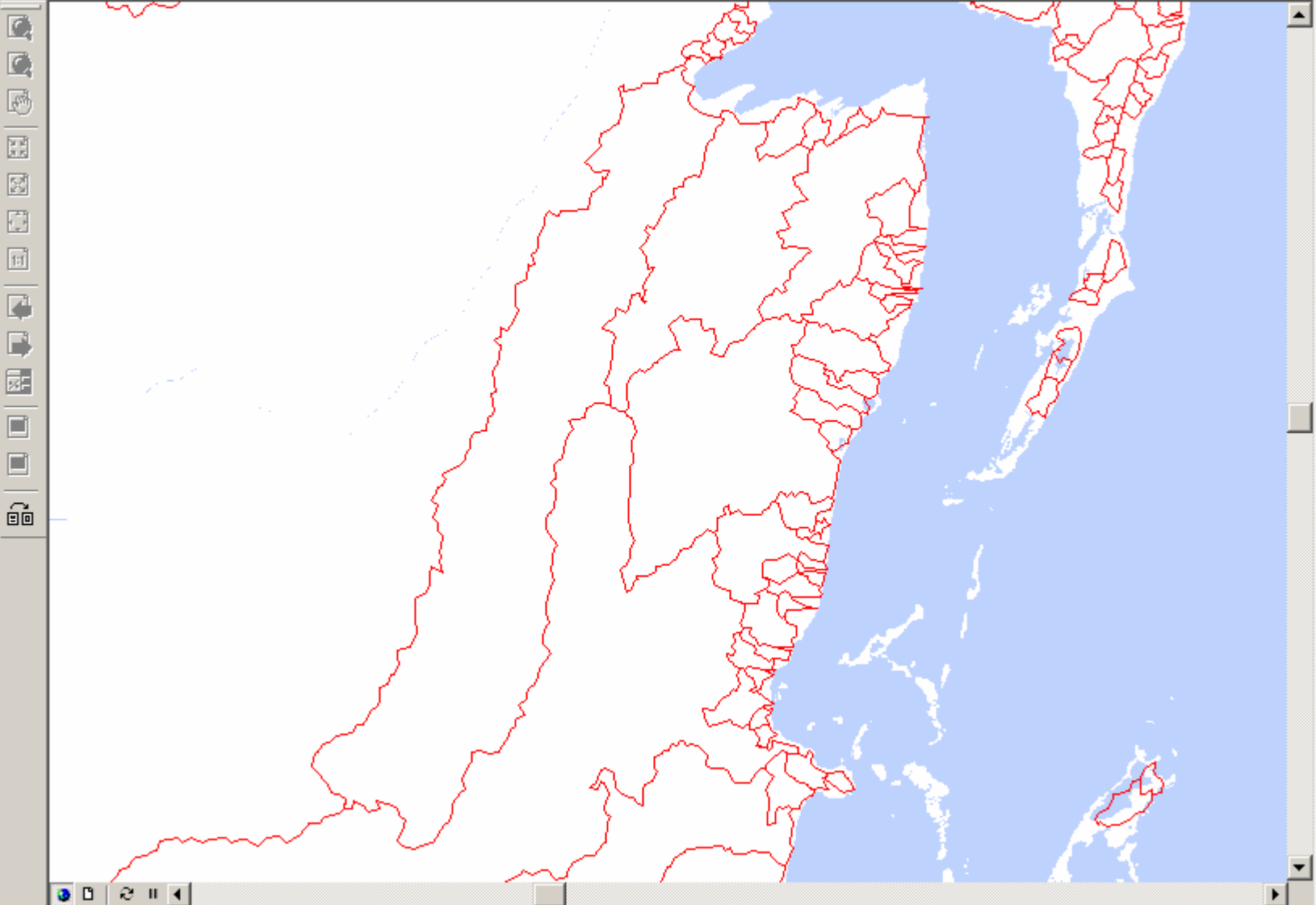
Results of Belize Expert Review

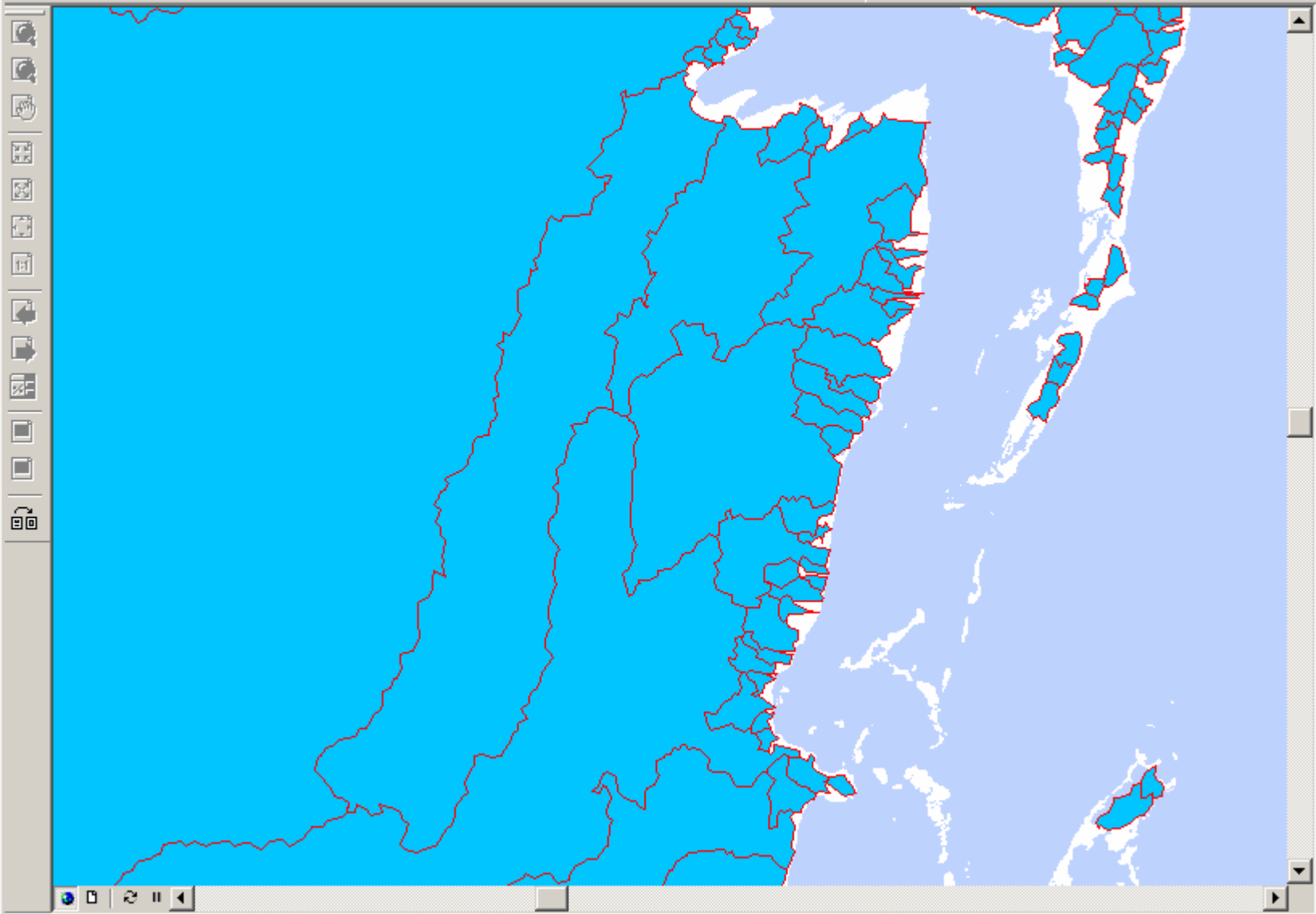
1. **Overall**, project results good and reveal worthwhile / critical investment of effort
2. **Watershed boundaries** look good, but must be re-drawn to reflect only the 18 major watersheds of Belize
3. **N-SPECT outputs** need to be explored further / validated
4. **Land Use scenarios** – group would like to know more about how scenario narratives translated to IMAGE 2 outputs (i.e. black box)
5. **Numerous possible applications** of project outputs (*e.g. overall land use planning; reporting to UNFCCC / UNCCD*)
